

Radicali Italiani and its commitment to Ukraine - A plaque to the Mayor of Kyiv

Radicali Italiani have been countering the expansionist and violent policies of Vladimir Putin since 1999, since his ascent to the Kremlin.

Radicali Italiani is a political formation that has been denouncing war crimes committed by Russia for over 20 years, first in Chechnya, then in Georgia, then in Syria and finally in Ukraine. Since 2014 it has supported the pro-European and democratic demands of Ukraine, against the invasion of Crimea, against the farce referendums promoted by Russia and against the support for Russian paramilitaries in Donbass.

On the 24th of February 2022, they launched the transnational campaign "Putin in The Hague", with an appeal in 9 languages, to ask for the indictment and trial of those responsible for crimes in Ukraine. The 10,000 signatures collected were handed over to the International Criminal Court a week before the arrest warrant was issued to President Putin.

On the occasion of April 25 – which in Italy is the symbolic date of liberation from fascism – a toplevel delegation will travel to Kyiv to support the Ukrainian resistance which is European resistance against the new world order promoted by Putin.

What Radicali Italiani demands is "April 25 also for Ukraine" and for this reason the delegation intends to deliver to the Mayor of Kyiv, Vitali Klitschko, the award plaque dedicated to the Ukrainian capital city that symbolizes the resistance to the assault of the Russian criminal army. A plaque that wants to represent the European brotherhood between the Italian people and the Ukrainian people, with the wish for a common future of peace and prosperity.

The plaque will be presented by the National Secretary of Radicali Italiani, Massimiliano Iervolino, by the Treasurer Giulia Crivellini and by the President Igor Boni in the presence of Italian journalists who are part of the delegation.
